

## **Airliners International 2020 PHX Postcard Contest Rules**

All registrants for Airliners International 2020 - Phoenix, are invited to submit an airline or airport postcard entry to highlight this fascinating aspect of our airline enthusiast hobby!

This year our Postcard Contest Rules have significantly changed, with new rules partly inspired by the successful postcard contest at last year's Aviation Weekend Frankfurt. We have made it much easier to enter -- without the need to devote a lot of time to preparing elaborate beautiful displays such as those that have been prizewinners in past Airliners International shows. If you would like to prepare an elaborate postcard display, you are most welcome to do so, and we will arrange for it to be exhibited at the show. However, for purposes of the AI 2020 Postcard Contest, here are the new rules:

### **Subject.**

In view of Airliners International 2020 being held in Phoenix, Arizona, in the Western U.S., the subject for the AI 2020 Postcard Contest is:

"My one favorite 'Airline' or 'Airport' postcard related to the 'Western U.S.' (defined for purposes of this contest as the portion of the U.S. west of the Mississippi River).

-- Specifically, a chosen 'Airline' must be one that presently flies, or has flown in the past, in the 'Western U.S.'. Any airport shown on any 'Airline' or 'Airport' postcard must be one located in the 'Western U.S.'.

-- If your favorite postcard is a chosen 'Airline', it may show an aircraft, airport in the 'Western U.S.', interior, flight deck, or personnel; or it may show a route map, menu or advertising if they relate to the 'Western U.S.'.

**Your Entry.** Each entry shall consist of:

(1) a **scan of the front, and a separate scan of the back** (each in JPEG format and minimum 300 dpi), **of one postcard from your collection that is on the Subject.**

(2) **text** (in Word format) - a brief explanation (maximum 150 words) **of why it is your favorite postcard on the Subject.**

### **Method of Submitting Entry.**

Submit the two separate scans of the front and back of your postcard, and your text, in the form noted above, **by 15 June 2020**, to the contest organizer, Marvin G. Goldman, at [registration@ai2020phx.com](mailto:registration@ai2020phx.com).

### **Display and Selection.**

Each qualifying Postcard Contest entry will be exhibited at the AI 2020 Phoenix show. Aviation postcard collectors and the general public will select the three top-winning entries, and they will be announced at the AI 2020 banquet on Saturday evening, 11 July 2020, with certificates being awarded.

### **Consent to Publicity.**

By entering the AI 2020 Postcard Contest, you agree that each of the World Airline Historical Society and Airlines International may show your entry on their respective websites and on any of their other publicity materials.
